

**Emergency Financial Manager of the City of Allen Park  
(Order No. 2013-007)**

**Order of the Emergency Financial Manager of the City of Allen Park, County of Wayne, State of Michigan, Approving a Water and Sewage Rate Increase According to Section 48-117 of the Rate and Fee Ordinance, and in Accordance to the Percentage Assessed by the City of Detroit.**

WHEREAS, under the Local Government Fiscal Responsibility Act, Act 72, Public Acts of Michigan, 1990 as amended (“Act 72”) and a contract (the “Contract”) between the State of Michigan and Joyce A. Parker, dated October 25, 2012, Joyce A. Parker has been appointed as the Emergency Financial Manager (the “EFM”) of the City of Allen Park, County of Wayne, Michigan (the “City”) and charged with the power to take actions with respect to the City, including the power to exercise the authority and responsibilities of the Mayor as the Chief Administrative Officer of the City, and of the City Council, as the governing body of the City, concerning the adoption, amendment and enforcement of ordinances or resolutions affecting the financial condition of the City as provided in the Home Rule City Act, Act 279, Public Acts of Michigan, 1909, as amended (“Act 279”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Act 72 and the Contract, the EFM, as the Chief Administrative Officer of the City, is authorized to, among other things, make, approve, or disapprove any appropriation, contract, expenditure, or loan for the City as she may deem necessary within her sole discretion to accomplish the purposes of Act 72; and

WHEREAS, the EFM has determined it is in the best financial interest of the City and necessary to accomplish the purposes of Public Act 72, to review the annual rate increases from the City of Detroit Water and Sewer Department to determine if the City’s rates required adjustments; and


FURTHERMORE, it is in the best interests of the City to increase the city’s existing rates for both water and sewer by the same percentage as assessed or charged by the City of Detroit at 5.74% for water purchases and 12.13% for sewage disposal.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE EMERGENCY FINANCIAL MANAGER OF THE CITY OF ALLEN PARK, PURSUANT TO ACT 72 AND THE CONTRACT, THAT:

1. In accordance with the rate and fee ordinance (section 48-117), The City of Allen Park increase its rate for water from 2.634 per 100 cubic feet to 2.785 per 100 cubic feet; and
2. In accordance with the rate and fee ordinance (section 48-117), The City of Allen Park increase its sewer rates from 2.266 per 100 cubic feet to 2.541 per 100 cubic feet.
3. Rates for capital improvement, sewer maintenance and meter services will not be changed.

4. Repeal. All orders of the EFM, resolutions of the City Council of the City and parts of resolutions or orders in conflict with this Order are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
