

**Emergency Financial Manager of the City of Allen Park
(Order No. 2012-004)**

Order of the Emergency Financial Manager of the City of Allen Park, County of Wayne, State of Michigan, Adopting the 80% - 20% cost-sharing model pursuant to Public Act 152 of 2011.

WHEREAS, under the Local Government Fiscal Responsibility Act, Act 72, Public Acts of Michigan, 1990 as amended ("Act 72") and a contract (the "Contract") between the State of Michigan and Joyce A. Parker, dated October 25, 2012, Joyce A. Parker has been appointed as the Emergency Financial Manager (the "EFM") of the City of Allen Park, County of Wayne, Michigan (the "City") and charged with the power to take actions with respect to the City, including the power to exercise the authority and responsibilities of the Mayor as the Chief Administrative Officer of the City, and of the City Council, as the governing body of the City, concerning the adoption, amendment and enforcement of ordinances or resolutions affecting the financial condition of the City as provided in the Home Rule City Act, Act 279, Public Acts of Michigan, 1909, as amended ("Act 279"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Act 72 and the Contract, the EFM, as the Chief Administrative Officer of the City, is authorized to, among other things, make, approve, or disapprove any appropriation, contract, expenditure, or loan for the City as she may deem necessary within her sole discretion to accomplish the purposes of Act 72; and

WHEREAS, Public Act 152 of 2011, was designed to lessen the burden of employee health care costs on public employers; and

WHEREAS, communities are given four options for complying with the requirements of Act 152, depending on the impact of the Act on the employees of each community; and


WHEREAS, the four options available to the City are:

- 1) to apply the hard cap to the amount each government employee may pay towards an employee's health care costs;
- 2) to adopt the 80% - 20% cost-sharing model;
- 3) to elect not to follow the act;
- 4) to opt out and exempt itself from the cost-sharing model as set forth in the act and revisit it prior to the next plan year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that

The Emergency Financial Manager for the City of Allen Park hereby adopts the 80% - 20% cost-sharing model as provided for pursuant to Public Act 152 of 2011 for the next succeeding year.
