

**Tires** – contact your local tire dealer. Most tire stores will accept old tires at a minimum charge, usually \$2.00 or \$3.00 each.

**Paint** – Wayne County HHWC will accept latex and oil base paint. see dates on the back cover or visit the city website at [www.cityoffallenpark.org](http://www.cityoffallenpark.org).

**Auto Batteries** – bring to DPS yard Monday thru Friday 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. (check in at the DPS Office prior to entering yard).

**Pharmaceutical Waste**  
Disposal of old/unused pills can be taken to Allen Park City Hall where they have a O.S.H.A. approved container that is collected on a routine basis and absolutely no cost to our residents. ### **ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING INCLUDE**

- Newspapers
- Magazines & Catalogs
- Glossy Prints & Junk Mail
- Cardboard - Cardboard must be cut into 2' x 2' sections and placed inside of the cart.
- **PIZZA BOXES (ONLY IF Bottom Liner is removed and there is NO Food, Cheese or Grease in or on the box)**
- Office & Computer Paper
- Glass (clear, brown, green – rinsed with lids removed). DO NOT INCLUDE drinking glass, Pyrex, plate glass, other colored glass, china, light bulbs, ceramics, or mirrors.
- Plastics #1 through #7. Labels can be left on, please rinse all items out completely.
- Aluminum & Metal (empty aerosol cans, lids from glass jars, food containers – rinsed well).

### **CURBSIDE COMPOST/YARD WASTE COLLECTION**

- Collection is every week on your scheduled day of service starting in the first full week of April through the second week of December. (April 4 through December 9)
- Leaves, grass clippings, yard waste must be in cans that clearly say “Compost” (“Compost” stickers are also available at City Offices), or in paper compost bags only.
- Brush must be bundled no larger than eighteen inches in diameter and four feet long.  
One individual item cannot be more than three inches in diameter.
- 50 POUND MAXIMUM WEIGHT ON CANS AND PAPER BAGS.
- PLASTIC BAGS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED - NO EXCEPTIONS.

For large amounts of brush, contact Department of Public Service, (313) 928-0550 for an estimate. All ends cut and facing the same direction. Once payment is made the brush will be scheduled for pickup.

**Warning:** Raking of leaves into the street is against the city ordinance. You could be ticketed and fined.

### **CURBSIDE BULK WASTE COLLECTION**

Bulk waste collection must be scheduled 24 hours in advance of your normal pickup day by calling Advanced Disposal at (888) 443-1717.

Bulk waste must be placed out prior to 7 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection. Residents are permitted up to 10 items of bulk waste and normal trash combined. Items accepted for collection include: tables, chairs, couches, televisions, entertainment centers, recliners, mattresses, box springs and carpet (cut and rolled into lengths not more than 4 feet long and weigh no more than 50 lbs), small wood pieces (nails pounded down) tied and no longer than 4' long. No building material tear outs will be picked up by the City of Allen Park. Riverview Landfill will accept construction material.

### **CURBSIDE WHITE GOODS/ APPLIANCE COLLECTION**

White goods/appliance collection must be scheduled 24 hours in advance of your normal collection day by calling Advanced Disposal at (888) 443-1717. Appliances must be placed curbside prior to 7 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.

Items accepted for collection include the following: washers, dryers, stoves, dishwashers, and hot water tanks, as well as, refrigerators, freezers (doors removed), air conditioners, humidifiers, de-humidifiers, etc. that DO NOT CONTAIN FREON.

Items containing Freon will need to have a sticker on the appliance.

Stickers must be purchased at City Hall and placed on the appliance prior to pick up. The cost of the sticker is \$55. Contact DTE Energy, (866) 796-0512, to inquire about their Appliance Recycling Program and current rebates.

## COLLECTION GUIDELINES

Advanced Disposal is proud to have been chosen by the City of Allen Park to be your waste and recycling services provider. Please know we will continue to provide the high quality and efficient collection you have come to expect.

### YOUR SERVICES ARE GETTING AN UPGRADE!

We are providing Allen Park residents with one 96-gallon garbage cart and one 64-gallon recycling cart. Wheeled carts with lids provide you with more room for more items, and help keep your neighborhood clean and green. In addition, collection will now be with an automated-side loading truck, a safer and more efficient way to service the city. Additional recycle carts and garbage carts can be purchased from Advanced Disposal (888) 443-1717.

### YOUR SERVICE SCHEDULES AND DAYS OF COLLECTION

**ALL TRASH, RECYCLING, COMPOST CARTS/BAGS MUST BE PLACED ON THE EASEMENT BETWEEN THE SIDEWALK AND CURB FOR PICK-UP.**

No Parking in the street from 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. on regular pickup day in your area.

**PLEASE DO NOT PUT CARTS IN STREET – INTERFERES WITH STREET SWEEPING AND SNOW REMOVAL OPERATIONS.**

### CART PLACEMENT: Be sure to follow these guidelines for proper cart placement.

Carts should be placed between the street curb and the sidewalk (grass area) or in the driveway approach (streets must remain clear for street sweeping and snow removal).

Cart handle should be facing the house and away from the street.

There needs to be at least three (3) feet between your cart and any other objects such as parked cars, light poles, mailboxes and other carts.

### CURBSIDE GARBAGE COLLECTION

Garbage collection is every week on your scheduled day of service in the provided 96-gallon wheeled cart. All garbage must be bagged and placed in the carts in order to be collected.

### CURBSIDE RECYCLING COLLECTION

Recycling collection is every other week on your scheduled day of service in the provided 64-gallon wheeled cart. Place all recyclables in the provided cart for single stream collection – no sorting is necessary.

All recyclables must be placed in the cart in order to be collected – **NO PLASTIC BAGS.**

(Plastic bags can be recycled at the Allen Park Meijer Store, Kroger Stores and other area retailers)
