POSITIONS: Field Organizer, Michigan Democratic Party.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Under the general supervision of the Political Organizing Director, undertake organizing activity on behalf of the Party among constituencies and young people, including but not limited to helping to start and strengthen College Democrat and Young Democrat organizations; assist local parties with Blue Tiger community service projects; assist county commission candidates; plan and execute organizing efforts and events; voter registration; train Party members and activists. During the six months prior to November in a General Election year, duties may be changed to include working on campaigns.

QUALIFICATIONS: A commitment to the goals and ideals of the Democratic Party is a prerequisite. Experience, either paid or as a volunteer, in political organizing preferred. Must be organized, responsible and able to work under pressure in a challenging political environment. Must be willing and able to travel extensively throughout Michigan. Computer literacy required.
