Re: City Administrator's Report to Council

1. Wayne County will be re-building the Moran Avenue Bridge over the Sexton and Kilfoil Drain (near Goddard & Old Goddard), and Moran Avenue is expected close shortly. Bricco will start to re-locate the water main on July 12th.
2. Street Improvement Millage: The Contractor (GV Cement) has poured all the concrete on the east side of Park Avenue from Regina Avenue to Angelique Avenue, including all the driveway approaches. They have started to remove the old asphalt and concrete on the west side of Park Avenue. They may pour the intersection at Park Avenue and Regina Avenue soon so it can be opened before July 4th.
3. Street Sectioning: The Contractor (Savone Cement) is nearly finished working on Philomene Boulevard between Fox Avenue and Colwell Avenue and between Rosedale Boulevard and the Lincoln Park border. They are also working Osage Avenue from Ecorse Road to Devonshire Street.
4. Al's Asphalt has paved the Police Impound Lot (part of the DPS Facility project), Beatrice Avenue, the Cunningham Park parking lot, the Community Center parking lot, and the roadway back to the old Mechanic's Garage. They will start paving six alleys in the DDA District tomorrow.
5. The Mechanic's Garage has moved into the new DPS Facility.
6. The Fire Ladder Truck has been repaired and returned to the Fire Department, but is still being readied to return to service.
7. The Demolition Specifications for the Allen Park Theater have been finalized and posted on the City website and the MITN Purchasing Group.
8. The Festivities Commission is planning the 2021 Allen Park Street Fair for Friday, August 6th, and Saturday, August 7th. The hours for both days will be 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM. There will be no beer, wine, or entertainment.
9. The following employee will reach a milestone in years of service with the City –
Kenneth Simerly (Code Enforcement) – 5 Years – July 1st
