**Re: City Administrator's Report to Council**

1. The Police and Fire departments have staff members that have begun Staff and Command school—Lt. Jeffrey Hada, Fire Department; Sgt. Ilie Fetelea, Police Department; Officer Steve Segrest, Police Department.
2. Officer Belknap will be completing the FTO program this week. Officer Rodgers will complete the FTO program next week.
3. The lead line replacement program is beginning next week. The program is currently funded through the Financially Distressed Cities Villages and Townships grant. Homeowners effected have been contacted by the Water & Sewer department.
4. Outdoor storage area for Great Lakes Ace through September 12<sup>th</sup> was approved by Administration on March 1<sup>st</sup> (there is no change from the previous three years).
5. The Home Sale Inspection program began on March 1<sup>st</sup>. Homes listed as of March 1<sup>st</sup> require a Certificate of Occupancy. Please contact the Building Department for additional information.
6. The Library has a weekly Knit & Crochet program taking place on Thursday nights from 6-7:30 p.m. There is also a monthly book discussion group. There is a group event on March 15<sup>th</sup> to discuss "The Heirloom Garden" by Viola Shipman. On April 19<sup>th</sup> they will meet to discuss "The Late Show" by Michael Connelly.
7. The next edition of Allen Park Today will be delivered the week of March 14<sup>th</sup>.
8. Finally, a BIG "congratulations" to the Allen Park High School Competitive Cheer team on their third consecutive State Cheer Championship. Congratulations also goes out to Nathan Robert who placed 4<sup>th</sup> at the Sate Bowling Tournament, Santana Ramon on his 6<sup>th</sup> place State wrestling finish, and Adeline Tuccini on her 5<sup>th</sup> place State wrestling finish. Adeline was also the first Allen Park High School female wrestler to place at the State competition.
