Re: City Administrator's Report to Council

1. Allen Road is closed at the Ecorse Creek (between Southfield Road and Outer Drive & in front of Thunderbowl) until approximately the end of the year. Wayne County will be replacing the bridge. Alternate routes/detours have been posted, but we are dealing with heavy traffic in the neighborhood. We need Wayne County to get the appropriate road closure signage in the appropriate areas.
2. Street Improvement Millage (GV Cement):
Park Avenue – The Contractor, GV Cement continues to work on the restoration and should be ready to lay sod by the middle of the month.
Robinson Avenue – GV is working on the restoration between Champaign and Devonshire. The full street between Devonshire and Brookshire has now been poured. In the next few days, the driveway approaches and sidewalks on the west side of the street will be poured.
Meyer Avenue – As GV starts to wrap up Robinson Avenue, they will soon start on the asphalt and concrete removal of Meyer Avenue between Quandt and Arno.
3. Water Main Replacement: The Contractor continues to work on the installation of the residential services. The homes with lead services have been a bit challenging.

4. Street Sectioning (Savone Cement):

Wick Road / Manor Avenue – The intersection of Wick Road and Manor Avenue remains closed.

Wick Road – The cross-over intersection at Becker Avenue is currently being worked on and is closed.

5. DPS Facility Project: GV is still working on the sanitary sewer lines and storm sewer lines. The roadway from Outer Drive is now accessible. The footing contractor is onsite building the wire footing cages and they should start pouring the concrete for the footings within the next few days. The steel beams and building are scheduled to be delivered later this month.
6. The Fire Department has cancelled their October Open House. They will post various items pertaining to fire safety via social media.
7. The second edition of Allen Park Today is scheduled to be delivered the week of September 21st. It is packed with more information about on-going projects, staff changes, real estate information, and highlights one of our volunteer groups.
