Re: Council Housekeeping Report

1. The paving project of Demean and Cleophus Streets is scheduled to start on Thursday, October 25th.
2. Water Main Replacement Project: Savone Cement is making repairs to Quandt Avenue between Regina and Thomas. This area was in really rough shape after two street replacement projects and two water main replacement projects.
3. The re-building of the Quandt Pump Station is expected to start November 1st.
4. The Court parking lot is tentatively scheduled to be sealed and pavement marked before the end of the month.
5. The Fire Chief submitted an Assistance to Firefighters Grant application for \$320,000 worth of equipment.
6. The Parks and Recreation Department continues to work with the MDNR on a grant for Humpty Dumpty Park, are working to expand the baseball field in Millward Park to high school size for next year, and are working with the Kiwanis Club to install a low 40" black aluminum fence in Duda Park.
7. The Tropical Smoothie Café on Southfield Road is now open, as well as Los Arcos Mexican Restaurant on Allen Road.
8. The DDA is sponsoring Trunk or Treat on October 26th at the Farmers Market.
9. We will host a Shred Day sponsored by Advanced Disposal on Saturday, October 27th from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM in the City Hall parking lot.

10. The 19th Annual Haunted Library will take place Saturday, October 27th from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM.
11. There will be a Veterans Day ceremony on Sunday, November 11th at noon in Champaign Park.
12. The Lighted Christmas Parade on Park Avenue will be held on Friday, November 16th starting at 6:30 PM. Preceding the parade, there will be a Tree Lighting at the Historical House at 6:00 PM.
13. City Hall and Police Department Project: DTE has been on-site today moving some wires to complete the installation of the Emergency Generator.
14. There will be a City Hall and Police Department Open House on Tuesday, October 30th from 4:30 to 8:00. This will include tours of the building.
