Re: City Administrator's Report to Council

1. Allen Road is still closed at the Ecorse Creek, but we have heard that it may be open by the end of this week.
2. The Belmont Avenue water main replacement project from Fox to Champaign has started the concrete replacement and restoration. The estimated timeframe until complete restoration should be two to three weeks – weather permitting.
3. The DPS and Parks & Recreation met with Al's Asphalt regarding the projects they will be working on. We anticipate seeing Al's working in the City in early June and wrapping up before July 1st – weather permitting.
4. The Allen Park Fire Department is offering In-Home Covid-19 Vaccinations (one dose Johnson & Johnson) for home-bound Allen Park residents through May 27th.
5. Deputy Chief Cann has worked with the Allen Park Public Schools to acquire an old school bus that will be used for fire training.
6. The Police Department has been working on the conversion to a new computer system that will allow them to be linked to most of the Downriver departments.
7. The Library has re-opened for 30 minute "Grab and Go" and internet computer sessions. Due to social distancing requirements, only five adult internet stations are open. Curbside Delivery still remains available.
8. City Hall and Police Records Bureau will be Closed on Thursday, May 20th from 8:30 AM to 1:00 PM for staff training.
9. The Festivities Commission is planning the 2021 Allen Park Street Fair for Friday, August 6th, and Saturday, August 7th. The hours for both days will be 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM. There will be no beer, wine, or entertainment, as they try to meet all of the Covid-19 mandates and keep social distancing in place.
