SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) Director Robert Gordon issued an [Emergency Order](#) requiring K-12 schools to provide highly visible public notices to the school community about probable and confirmed cases of COVID-19 within 24 hours. This order goes into effect on Monday, October 12.

- MDHHS Director Robert Gordon issued Emergency Orders under MCL 333.2253 that maintain protections for Michigan's most vulnerable populations and staff in residential and congregate care settings and juvenile justice facilities on October 6th. [The residential care order](#) has three major components: notice requirements regarding cases, limitations on visitations and limitations on communal dining. There are different visitation rules for child caring facilities and [juvenile justice](#) facilities. This order is effective immediately and remains in effect through Friday, October 30th.

- On October 6, Governor Whitmer signed [Senate Bill 757](#) in an effort to help the State of Michigan ensure every vote is counted in the upcoming November election. SB 757 would allow clerks in certain cities or townships to begin processing absentee ballots prior to election day. It would also provide that clerks will notify voters of any reason their vote won't be counted within 48 hours. **Source: Michigan Executive Office of the Governor**
