SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- A vaccine for COVID-19 is coming, but no one in the state knows exactly when. Ohio has been preparing for how the vaccine will be distributed and it's all detailed in a 55-page [report](#) released in October. According to the state's interim-draft COVID-19 distribution plan, one of the major concerns is that "50% of Americans report they are unsure or would refuse being vaccinated."—**WBNS**
- Six White House aides and a Trump campaign adviser — including Mark Meadows, President Trump's chief of staff — have contracted the coronavirus, officials said, raising fears of another outbreak sweeping through the ranks of the nation's top officials as cases surge to record levels in the country.—**The New York Times**
- A Missouri elections supervisor who knew they tested positive for the coronavirus and still worked at a polling site Election Day has died. The unidentified election judge supervisor tested positive for the virus on Oct. 30 and failed to isolate for the recommended two-week period, county officials said. It is unclear if the cause of death was related to the virus.—**NBC News**
- A CDC [study](#) has found that pregnant women with SARS-CoV-2 infection are at increased risk for severe illness compared with non-pregnant women. Adverse pregnancy outcomes such as preterm birth and pregnancy loss have been reported. Among 3,912 infants with known gestational age born to women with SARS-CoV-2 infection, 12.9% were preterm (<37 weeks), higher than a national estimate of 10.2%. Among 610 (21.3%) infants with testing results, 2.6% had positive SARS-CoV-2 results, primarily those born to women with infection at delivery.—**CDC**
