SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- As the number of new COVID-19 cases surges each day in many parts of the country, some states are hitting pause on their plans to reopen. Dr. Anthony Fauci of the National Institutes of Health said that while states may not need to revert to the strictest possible measures, some may want to consider adjusting their reopening plans. "I wouldn't necessarily say an absolute shutdown, lockdown, but if someone is going from gateway to Phase 1 to Phase 2 and they get into trouble in Phase 2, they may need to go back to Phase 1," he said.
- The United Arab Emirates (UAE) and China have launched a Phase 3 clinical trial of a COVID-19 vaccine, according to the China National Biotech Group (CNBG) and UAE state media. The launch is another development in the race to find a scientific solution to the pandemic.
- The University of Washington's Institute for Health Metrics and Evaluation (IHME) has released an updated model projecting that the U.S. is on track to have an additional 58,000 COVID-19 related deaths between now and October 1; however, 33,000 of those American lives could be saved if almost everyone wore masks.
- The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) is warning the public regarding fraudulent stimulus check phone calls that try to trick you into giving out your personal information. "Government agencies usually will not call or email you — especially about something related to money. They almost always contact you by US mail," the FTC said.
- Governor Whitmer signed Executive Order [2020-132](#), which continues to allow certain state administrative hearings to be held by video conference or phone in place of in-person hearings. This order is effective immediately and remains in effect through July 31, 2020.
- Governor Whitmer signed Executive Order [2020-133](#), which sets guidelines for the safe return of professional sports, without a live audience. The order follows Major League Baseball's announcement that a shortened 60-game season would begin on July 24 with players reporting for spring training at their home ballparks by July 1.

ACTIONS TAKEN

- The Wayne Co. Dept. of Public Health has partnered with Garden City Hospital in the development of the [Save-A-Life](#) program to provide COVID-19 drive-up diagnostic and antibody testing for Wayne County employees, Wayne County residents, and the general public with no out-of-pocket cost or pre-scheduled appointment. The program also simplifies the donation of convalescent plasma for individuals with positive antibodies that wish to donate.
