## SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Due to the financial consequences of the COVID-19 pandemic, Beaumont Health has announced that it is:
  - Temporarily laying off 2,475 employees (mostly hospital administrative staff and others who are not directly caring for patients with or without COVID-19).
  - Permanently eliminating 450 positions.
  - Temporarily decreasing executive pay—Beaumont Health CEO John Fox will take a 70% temporary pay cut to his base salary and the other members of Beaumont's executive leadership will take temporary pay cuts up to 45% of their total compensation.
- Governor Whitmer has announced a partnership with CVS Health to provide drive-through Rapid COVID-19 Testing in Dearborn as part of the ongoing effort to expand testing for the virus statewide. The process takes about 30 minutes total and will be available to pre-screened and registered patients by appointment seven days a week.
- Congress has reached an agreement on a \$450 billion (USD) relief package with \$310 billion (USD) for the Paycheck Protection Program that will provide help to small businesses. "Of the \$310 billion (USD), \$125 billion (USD) will be sent exclusively to the unbanked, minorities, rural areas and all of the small stores that don't have a good banking connection and need help", stated Senate Minority Leader Chuck Schumer.
