SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Pharmaceutical company Moderna intends to apply early this week to the FDA for authorization of its COVID-19 vaccine. The company will ask the FDA to review an expanded data set showing the vaccine is 94.1% effective at preventing COVID-19 and 100% effective at preventing severe cases of the disease.—**CNN**
- Across the country, medical personnel are now bracing for what they fear will be a new wave of infections. "We may see a surge upon a surge," said Dr. Anthony Fauci, the nation's top infectious disease expert. "We don't want to frighten people, but that's just the reality."—**NPR**
- Family and co-workers of Wayne County Sheriff Benny Napoleon gathered Sunday (Nov. 29) to pray for him to fully recover from coronavirus. Napoleon was put on a ventilator Friday night (Nov. 27). His family said he made the decision to allow his body to heal. Napoleon's daughter, Tiffani Jackson, said she is more than appreciative of all the support from those who want to see him pull through.—**Click on Detroit**
- Just days before Thanksgiving, a Michigan family lost both of their parents to COVID-19. Leslie and Patricia McWaters spent nearly 50 years together before dying on the same day, one minute apart. "It's tough enough to lose one, parent but this was the worst," daughter Joanna Sisk said. Like the thousands of Michiganders who've lost loved ones to the virus, Sisk said it's agonizing to hear others brush off the risk.—**Click on Detroit**
