## SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Governor Gretchen Whitmer has asked the Michigan legislature to pass the following [measures](#): a \$100 million (USD) MI COVID-19 Relief Plan, a permanent extension of unemployment benefits, and a bill that would protect public health. —**WXYZ**
- Sunday, US Surgeon General Dr. Jerome Adams said he expects the rise in COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations to continue. He stated, "I want to be straight with the American people, it's gonna get worse over the next several weeks... the actions that we take in the next several days will determine how bad it is or whether or not we continue to flatten our curve." —**CNN**
- New York University-Langone Professor of Medicine Dr. Marc Siegel urges the public to accept the forthcoming COVID-19 vaccines, stating that the rare reported side effects are both quickly dispatched with and less severe than some of the more extreme symptoms of the virus itself. —**Fox News**
- Michigan's COVID-19 cases update for Saturday represented 8,080 new cases and 103 additional deaths since Friday. Officials said 70 of those deaths were identified after reviewing records, meaning they did not occur between Friday and Saturday. —**Click on Detroit**
- A Singaporean woman who was 10-weeks pregnant when she fell ill with COVID-19 this March has given birth to a baby boy who has COVID-19 antibodies. This offers a new clue as to whether the infection can be transferred from mother to child. —**Aljazeera**
