SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Gilead Sciences, a research-based biopharmaceutical company will begin a trial of an inhaled formulation of Remdesivir—currently an intravenously administered drug that received Emergency Use Approval from the FDA to treat COVID-19 patients. The inhaled version would be given through a nebulizer which would allow for easy administration outside of a hospital setting during early stages of the disease.
- Brazil is the second country in the world with the highest number of COVID-19 cases, following the USA. In a one-week period from June 15 to June 21, the Brazilian Ministry of Health reported 7,285 deaths due to COVID-19—an average of more than 1,000 deaths per day.
- The White House has announced that the Trump administration is preparing for a possible second wave of COVID-19 this fall. Although 29 states and U.S. territories have reported an increase in their seven-day average of newly reported cases, the White House trade adviser Peter Navarro disclosed the preparations for the possible second wave but rejected the suggestion that a second wave had already taken hold.
- The American Academy of Pediatrics has compiled a [Children and COVID-19: State-Level Data Report](#) that includes statistics from 49 states, as well as New York City, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and Guam. As of 6/11/20, the data shows that children represented only 5.6% of 1,750,240 confirmed cases of COVID-19.
- The University of Michigan has released its pandemic plan for the school's Fall semester which falls in line with other released protocols from public universities around Michigan that have already released their plans. A mix of in-person and remote learning will be offered for students at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, Flint, and Dearborn. The hybrid learning style allows students to return to campus whenever they'd like as every course will be taught in both manners.
