SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- President-elect Joe Biden plans to meet Monday with his new coronavirus taskforce and give remarks about his plans for tackling the pandemic, as well as rebuilding the economy. "Dealing with the coronavirus pandemic is one of the most important battles our administration will face, and I will be informed by science and by experts," Biden said.—**New York Post**
- President-elect Joe Biden will personally call on governors around the country to enact mask mandates in their states once taking office next year. A Biden campaign official said that governors who resist the incoming president's requests will see Biden pressure mayors of cities in their respective states to enact mandates at the local level.—**The Hill**
- The drug company Pfizer said that early analysis showed its candidate for COVID-19 is more than 90 percent effective in preventing infection. It said no serious safety concerns were observed in the trial, and that it would apply for emergency use authorization to the U.S. Food and Drug Administration after a key safety hurdle was passed, likely in mid-November.—**NBC News**
- In a [paper](#) published in *Science*, scientists have found that one of the more surprising symptoms of COVID-19 has been the blood clots that many patients, including younger ones, have experienced with the infection. The clots have in some cases led to dangerous blockages in the lungs, caused strokes and even death, even in people without a history of circulatory conditions.—**Time**
