SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Due to the nationwide protests over the death George Floyd, the United States Surgeon General Dr. Jerome Adams warns of new COVID-19 outbreaks as a result of thousands of people gathering in close proximity.
- President Trump has approved Governor Whitmer's request to extend the federal deployment of the Michigan National Guard known as Title 32 authority allowing the Michigan National Guard to continue assisting to combat the COVID-19 pandemic until August 21, 2020.
- As regions across Michigan continue to advance under the [MI Safe Start plan](#), Governor Whitmer signed Executive Order [2020-112](#) announcing the certain rescissions from the following executive orders:
 - Executive Order [2020-38](#) – which extends certain FOIA deadlines due to COVID-19, will be rescinded at 12:00 am on June 11, 2020.
 - Executive Order [2020-39](#) – which provides temporary relief from certain restrictions and requirements governing the provision of emergency medical services is rescinded, effective immediately.
 - Executive Order [2020-82](#) – which provides temporary enhancements to operational capacity and efficiency of health care facilities is rescinded, effective immediately.
- The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) Director Robert Gordon issued an epidemic order, "[Exceptions to temporary restrictions on entry into certain facilities](#)", expanding visitation rules in hospitals, outpatient clinics and doctor's offices.
- During a live Q&A session with the Journal of the American Medical Association, Dr. Anthony Fauci, the director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID) provided an update on the development of a COVID-19 vaccine and stated, " ...by the beginning of 2021, we hope to have a couple hundred million doses... Scientists should have enough data by November or December to determine if the vaccine works".
