SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Housing and Urban Development Secretary Ben Carson tested positive for coronavirus on Nov. 9, his deputy chief of staff Coalter Baker confirmed. "Secretary Carson has tested positive for the coronavirus. He is in good spirits and feels fortunate to have access to effective therapeutics which aid and markedly speed his recovery," Baker said in a statement.—**CNN**
- As part of the state's continued efforts to slow the increasing spread of COVID-19, MDHHS and Michigan Department of Technology, Management and Budget (DTMB) announced on Nov. 9, the statewide rollout of the COVID-19 exposure notification app MI COVID Alert. The anonymous, no cost and voluntary app, users know whether they may have recently been exposed to COVID-19. Users can confidentially submit a positive test result into the app and alert others in recent proximity that they may have also been exposed to the virus.—**Michigan State Police**
- Critical relief totaling nearly \$100 million for more than 14,000 small businesses across the state has been awarded to date through the [Michigan Small Business Restart Grant](#) program, Governor Gretchen Whitmer announced.—**Michigan.gov**
- Production of the University of Oxford/AstraZeneca coronavirus vaccine began on Nov. 9. Thirty million doses of the vaccine will enter manufacturing in Victoria, Australia. "[The vaccine] is going to be voluntary, but we will encourage as many people as possible," said Health Minister, Greg Hunt. "We are confident that we will have a very high take-up amongst the Australian population," he added.—**TOI**
