### SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Wayne County is currently in **MEDIUM** overall community levels
- Wear a mask indoors and on public transportation -see Wayne County Covid-19 webpage for further recommendation [www.waynecounty.com/COVID19dashboard](http://www.waynecounty.com/COVID19dashboard)
- Wayne County is offering the **Bivalent Booster** for ages 12 and older. You're eligible to receive this booster if it has been at least 2 months since completing your primary series or receiving your last booster dose —**WC**
- It takes several weeks after each dose of COVID-19 vaccine for your body to develop maximum levels of immunity – you are not protected right away. We still don't know exactly how long protection from COVID-19 vaccines lasts but most people have strong protection against serious illness and death for at least 6 months —**WHO**
- If you have COVID-19 you can spread the virus to others. There are precautions you can take to prevent spreading it to others: isolation, masking, and avoiding contact with people who are at high risk of getting very sick. Isolation is used to separate people with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 from those without COVID-19 —**CDC**
- Travel –follow CDC's recommendations for wearing masks while traveling and in public transportation settings such as airplanes—**CDC**
- Get tested after travel if your travel involved situations with greater risk of exposure such as being in crowded places while not wearing a high-quality mask respirator —**CDC**
